Good depth of chest. Hindquarters well muscled. Moved and presented well. 2. Whitehead's, Robrairie Jack Daniels. Blue roan. Lovely youngster. Well boned and tight feet. Front and body look good. Strong hindquarters. Moved with ease. 3. Driver's, Beckaby Careless Whisper. SpND. (4). 1. Pretty's, Joaldy Young Love. Blue roan. Lovely head and eye. Good in neck and shoulders. Deep chest. Short coupled. Good topline. Moved well from strong quarters. Showed well. 2. Driver's, Beckaby Careless Whisper. Blue roan. Attractive dog stood. Well balanced. Moved ok. Presented well. 3. Gray's, Graysaxon Treasured Gift. SpGD. (5). 1. Pretty's, Joaldy Young Love. 2. Warrington's, Tipperlin Designed for Zakova. Orange and white. Pleasing head, well constructed throughout. Shown in fit condition. Moving well for his owner. 3. Craig's, Withiflor Blues in the Night at Alisma. SpOD. (5). 1. Grice's, Sh Ch. Kyna by Request. Light blue roan. This dog caught my eye, full of quality and character. Loved his head. Correct reach of neck with good lay of shoulder and well sprung ribs. Hindquarters well muscled. Good tail set. Flowing movement. Excellent drive. Moved sound and true. 2. Amos-Jones's, Sh Ch. Cassom Hey Jude JW. Blue roan. Another quality dog. Nothing to dislike about him. Superhead with gentle expression. Excels in bone and hard condition. Excellent overall balance and construction. Flowing neck into well laid shoulders. Good depth. Strong quarters. Moved and shown well. 3. Nicholas-Steel and Nicholas', Sh Ch. Glentree Lets Jive in Kalrizienne JW. RED/GOLDEN/LIVER and TAN SpGD. (2). 1. Brown and Crossley's, Atherbron Call me Trouble JW. Red. Handsome head. Well placed shoulders. Deep through chest. Good topline. Correct ribcage. Well turned hindquarters. Moved soundly with drive. Well presented and handled. 2. Hartnett's, Glentree Gondolier. Golden. Strong headed and well built dog. Tail did not stop wagging. Really enjoyed his day showing. SpOD. (3). 1. Share-Jones's, Sharemead Golden Syrup JW. Golden. Very pleasing dog to go over. Excellent head and expression. Good reach of neck, shoulders and lovely ribcage. Strong hindquarters. Excels in bone and substance. Very powerful dog on the move. Really liked him. 2. Hutching's, Cascadia I Chico at Beechtops. Golden. Nice head. Good reach of neck. Good front. Well balanced throughout. Happy mover. Well presented. BLACK / BLACK and TAN SpPD. (5). 1. Marris-Bray's, Helenwood Black Ice. Black dog 10 months old. Was taken back by the strength and substance of this puppy. Handsome head. Strong neck, deep chest. Well bodied with well sprung rib. Strong muscled quarters giving good movement. Needs more coat to finish but when this comes one to watch out for BP. 2. Costello's, Judika Full Moon. Black. really liked this puppy as well. Very eye catching and so well presented and handled. Superb head and nice expression. Has the same as my winner, good neck, deep chest, well sprung ribs. Good muscled hindquarters. Lovely mover. When he matures another one to watch in the future. 3. Flowers', Totenkopf Dutch Courage. SpGD. (8). 1. Gain's, Molkara Magician. Black and tan. Full of potential. Good balanced outline. Super head, good length of neck and well laid shoulders. Strong front. Short coupled. Good bend of stifle. Moved with plenty of reach and drive. Well handled and presented. He showed himself really well. 2. Warrington's, Zakova Hypnotist JW. Black. Lovely head and expression. Good front and topline. Strong rear end. Presentation immaculate. Showed well. 3. Flowers', Totenkopf Dutch Doubloon JW. SpOD. (2). 1. Pretty and Carpenter's, Totenkopf War Games at Joaldy JW Sh CM. Always liked this one as a pup. Good head, neck and front. Good depth of chest. Muscled hindquarters. Good tail set. Strong condition. Moved and showed well. 2. Rowland's, Perrytree Midnight Sky. Black. Handsome head. Correct reach of neck. Well sprung ribs. Good turn of stifle. Lovely outline when stood. Well presented. AC VD. (5). Really enjoyed judging this class, lovely to see and handle these lovely oldies. Beared in mind the age of any entrant in Veteran and with all such sound movers it really was showmanship and condition that settled the placings. 1. Pearce-Gudger's, Marquell Moving Glance at Pearkim. Orange roan 9 years old and looking good. Good head, neck and lay of shoulder. Excellent legs and feet. Correct ribcage for depth and length. Well muscled hindquarters with good tail carriage. In well presented coat and condition. Handled to best advantage. BVIS. 2. Gillespie

and Wilding's, Sh Ch. Lochranza for Your Eyes Only. Golden 7 years old. Well known dog. Very fit boy for age and his movement is still precise up and down. Good type dog. Sturdy well balanced build with nice head, front and forechest. Topline good. Strong rear end. Handled well. 3. Bowman's, Asquanne's Goldstein at Franaille Sh CM.

MPD. (12). 1. Hatton's, Royaldean Havok. Black and white ticked. Very striking quality young man in good condition. Well boned and hard muscle. Pleasing head and kind expression. Good depth of chest. Well balanced. Moved with effortless, ground covering action. 2. Pearce-Gudger's, Pearkim Pumpkinpie. Orange roan. Another promising puppy. Good head and expression. Good bone and feet. Well bodied for age. Good front, topline and hindquarters. Well presented. 3. Amos-Jones's, Cassom Star Alliance.

Super moving dog whose coat was in pristine condition and very well handled. 2. Ellison's, Withiflor Northern Light. Black. Handsome head. Good shoulders. Good depth and spring of rib. Hindquarters well muscled. Lovely type of dog. Well presented. 3. Pheasant's, Molkara Druids Quest at Chamerl.

YD. (7). 1. Wilding's, Jayzander Murphy's Law JW. Light blue roan. Nice head and eye. Well balanced, short coupled. Good rear quarters. Lovely bone. In strong condition. Happy mover. Well shown. 2. Brown and Crossley's, Atherbron Call Me Trouble JW. 3. Worgan's, Luthame Mr Bond.

UGD (8). 1. Forfar's, Craigdean Kokrhoop at Glasedin. Blue roan. Good strong head. Well balanced. Well boned. Good spring of rib and bend of stifle. Moved well. 3. Pretty's, Joaldy Young Love.

PGD. (6). 1. West's, Sheigra Starstruck JW. Black. Good head. Nice dog all over. Short coupled. Strong mover. Well presented and handled. 2. Shapland's, Deracor Dark Legend. Black. Slightly larger dog than winner but similar in comments. Just splitting hairs. Good movement. 3.

SpBEGIN D (8). 1. Reader's, Kaniboo Midnight Diamond. Black. Good head and eye. Good front, loads of depth. Good topline. Strong hindquarters. Good condition to coat, well presented. 2.

Driver's, Beckaby Lunar Shadow. Light blue. Pleasing head. Nice front. Good forearm. Short coupled. Nice rear end. Moved well. 3. Gladman's, Chativore Steel Symphony.

LD. (9). 1. Pretty and Carpenter's, Joaldy Mandolin Wind JW. Black and white. Good size. Striking masculine dog of substance with all it takes for a bright future. Super head and expression. Good neck into good clean shoulderline. Super topline and tail carriage. Strong quarters. Deserved his RCC. Caught my eye from start to finish. 2. Gain's, Molkara Exige. Black. Lovely head, excellent front. Good shoulder and depth. Sound rear end not over done. Moved and showed well. 3. Amos-Jones's, Cassom Rock Star.

OD. (6). 1. Bentley's, Sh Ch. Canigou Rocket Science. Black. What an outstanding dog. I have admired him from the ringside. I certainly was not disappointed on handling him. He has it all. Fabulous head, body, chest depth, topline, tail set and carriage. Correct muscled well angulated rear hindquarters. Sound front and rear. Moves so well. Oozes quality. Loved him. Handled well.
