### **Particolour**

Class 1: Special Puppy (Ent 4, abs 2)

Two quality youngsters who both have much to like and I'm sure a promising future.

1<sup>st</sup> Lowrey's Amaroanne Apollo – Dark blue of 9 months, eye-catching outline, dark eye and soft expression, good stop, clean in throat with super reach of neck, good layback of shoulder, with good width and depth of brisket. Well developed in rib and overall substance. I liked his overall balance, with well let-down hocks and good rear angulation, short coupled and sound in movement.

2<sup>nd</sup> Whitehead's Royaldean Aramis – 7 ½ month mid blue, lovely classic head and expression, close up to winner and has much to be admired, slightly longer in leg and lacking the substance of the winner, overall balance and of type to be admired. Sound happy mover, a smart young man.

Class 2: Special Novice (Ent 1, abs 1)

Class 3: Special Graduate (Ent 4, abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Wildman's Reemif Midnight blue for Chanmalo SH CH. Dark blue of 2 years, masculine head with softest of expression, this blue has much to like, substance throughout with good reach of neck and good in front assembly. Showed in fine order, moved soundly.

2<sup>nd</sup> Anderson's Cassom Caravaggio at Linchael. Dark blue of 2 years, not the maturity of the winner, dark eye, balanced throughout, moved soundly of quality type.

3<sup>rd</sup> - Metinon's Serci Little Blue Boy Ali (Imp Serbia)

Class 4: Special Open (Ent 3, abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Amos Jones SH CH Veratey Vincenzo at Cassom JW. Eye-catching blue with the softest of expression, with substance and overall balance. Super front assembly, clean in neck and throat. Well developed in fore-chest, deep in brisket, good reach of neck and layback of shoulders. Standing on strong bone, lovely padded feet, good depth of second thigh and well-muscled, well-angulated with let down hocks. Good forereach in movement and covers the ground effortlessly, shown in fine order. Happy to award him my RCC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Thomas' SH CH Claramand Ziggy Ziggy JW. Orange roan who has much to be admired. He possesses many outstanding qualities, a masculine head without coarseness, substance and breed type that is to be appreciated.

### **Red/Golden/Liver/Liver & Tan**

Class 5: Special Puppy (Ent 1, abs 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Warrington's Zakova Sunburst. Gold boy of nearly 12 months. Masculine head with soft expression, dark eye, good reach of neck and layback of shoulders, well developed in fore-chest and substance in bone and build. Lovely well-padded feet, happy mover once settled, shown in fine order.

Class 6: Special Graduate (Ent 1, abs 1)

Class 7: Special Open (Ent 2, abs 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Adam's Port./GI CH Corralet Amor Brujo. Eye-catching gold of 3 ½ years, masculine head with soft expression, dark eye and super reach of neck. Deep in fore-chest with good return of upper arm and substance standing on strong bone. Well-muscled, good bend of stifle and good depth in second thigh, well let down hocks, sound in movement, showed in fine order.

2<sup>nd</sup> Grinor and MacFarlane's Lochranza Lord of the Isles. Gold, in good order for his 7 years, not the substance of the winner, kind eye and expression, firm top-line, sound and happy in movement.

### **Black/Black & Tan**

Class 8: Puppy Dog (Ent 3, abs 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Mace's Sirius Black Del Re Di Danari Fonese (Import: Italy). Black of 9 months with pleasing outline. Good reach of neck and overall substance. Shown in good order, moved well once settled.

2<sup>nd</sup> Davies' Kerringlow Witch Craft. Black of just seven months, very much a baby. Masculine head, square muzzle, dark eye with soft expression, good reach of neck. Short coupled, promising puppy.

3<sup>rd</sup> Lundin's Line Sam Appealing Partner (Import: Sweden)

Class 9: Special Graduate (Ent 2, abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Lundborg's Line Sam Gaze for Hugs. Eye-catching black and tan of 19 months. Masculine and balanced head, good pigmentation. Short coupled, deep in fore-chest, good return of upper arm, in lovely coat and condition. Moved out with drive and purpose.

Class 10: Special Open (Ent 3, abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Pollock's Thurness The Illusionist. Stylish black and tan of 5 years. Compact with overall balance and of cockery type. Deep in fore-chest and super spring of rib, good return of upper arm and good bend of stifle. Good muscle tone in thigh with good depth and well let down hocks. Sound and happy in movement, in fine order, showed to advantage.

2<sup>nd</sup> Farebrother's Lilyvale Charmen. 3 year old black and tan, larger frame than the winner. This young man has substance, a masculine head, dark eye and the softest expression. Moved okay once settled.

### **Any Colour**

Class 11 – Veteran (Ent 6, abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Costello's Judika Arizona. Black and tan of 7 years, stunning outline, balanced head, square muzzle, soft expression, good spring of rib, deep in fore-chest, overall substance, standing on good bone, lovely cat-like feet, short coupled, standing four square. Good bend of stifle and balance in rear angulation. Shown in fine order, moved with drive and purpose. Was pleased to see him awarded BVIS.

2<sup>nd</sup> Cox's Suvern Softly Spoken. Blue of nearly 9 years, not the substance or balance of the winner. This boy has well-balanced head, with kind eye and expression. In lovely coat and condition, of honest type, a sound and happy mover with drive and purpose.

3<sup>rd</sup> – Wheatley's Wilmerella Keep Dancing with Melandroy

Class 12 – Minor puppy (Ent 17, abs 4)

My class of the day with some very promising puppies, sadly with such a high number of puppies some lovely youngsters were unplaced today.

1<sup>st</sup> Share Jones' Sharenead The Conqueror. This young 6 ½ month old blue baby has much to like, masculine head without coarseness. Lovely deep square muzzle, soft in expression with substance standing on good bone, well barrelled ribs. I liked his balance and overall cockery type with nothing overdone. Balance in rear angulation, sound and happy in movement. His development is reflective of his age, and his coat is how it should be. I look forward to seeing this young man develop. I feel he should have a bright future. BMPD, BPD.

2<sup>nd</sup> Grice's Brackjack Ollison at Kyna. Another very promising puppy who has much to like, well developed for his 6 ½ months, with overall substance. Not the development in the head of the winner, but I'm sure this will come with time. Lovely reach of neck and layback of shoulders, deep in fore-chest, well barrelled ribs. Sound and happy mover.

3<sup>rd</sup> Anslow's Craigdean Orr Jimmie at Shansart

Class 13 – Puppy(Ent 5, abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Britton's Tyluly Ice Kool. Eye-catching black of 9 months, masculine head, softest of expression. This young man has many qualities, dark eye, good reach of neck and super in front assembly, lovely well-padded feet, substance throughout. Shown in fine order and moved to advantage with drive and purpose, happy and confident on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> Warrington's Zokova sunburst

3<sup>rd</sup> Lowrey's Amaroanne Theos

Class 14 – Junior (Ent 1, abs 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Pearce Gudger's Glowhill Silversmith for Pearkim. Black and white, eye-catching of cockery type. Good reach of neck, well put together, moved soundly. Stood alone but worthy of this place card.

Class 15 – Yearling (Ent 6, abs 2)

1<sup>st</sup> Robertson's Kastrian Affection JW. Quality black of 20 months in super coat and condition. Lovely head and expression with dark eye, good reach of neck and return of upper arm. I liked his balance, substance and overall type. Good bend of stifle and muscle tone in thigh, well let down hocks, sound in movement. Shortlisted in my final line up, much to like and should have a bright future, a credit to his breeder.

2<sup>nd</sup> Forfar's Bartonholm Bacetta. Blue of 21 months, masculine head without coarseness, balanced in overall construction, good reach of neck, deep in fore-chest and good width in front assembly. Moved with drive and purpose.

3<sup>rd</sup> Lundborgs Line Sam Goze for Hugs

Class 16 – Novice (Ent 4, abs 4)

Class 17 – Undergraduate (Ent 4, abs 3)

1<sup>st</sup> Mehrhen's Serci Little Blue Boy Ali (Import: Serbia). Mid-blue of 2 ½ years, short, coupled and of cockery type, balanced in overall construction with nothing overdone. Kind eye and expression, moved out well with a happy and outgoing disposition.

Class 18 – Postgraduate (Ent 9, abs 2)

1<sup>st</sup> Collin's Cachel King of hearts of Candyke JW. Dark blue with masculine head, kind eye and expression. I liked this dogs elegance and balance with good reach of neck. Substantial in construction and bone, strong in rear quarters. This young man still has more to come in his development to finish the overall picture, moved with drive and purpose. Shown in fine order.

2<sup>nd</sup> Square and Adam's Corazon De Sibi Night Star (Import: Spain) JW. Compact blue of 2 years and soft in expression. Deep in fore-chest and substance throughout. Short coupled with lovely well-padded feet and shown in top condition. Sound happy mover.

3<sup>rd</sup> Wildmans Reemiff Midnight blue for Chanmalo

Class 19 – Special Beginners (Ent 3, abs 2)

1<sup>st</sup> Seri Little Blue boy Ali (Import: Serbia).

Class 20 – Limit (Ent 6, abs 3)

1<sup>st</sup> Gilmore's Chavez Royal Performance. Eye-catching black of 4 years. Masculine head with dark eye and soft expression, super in front assembly, deep in fore-chest, lovely reach of neck and return of upper arm, standing on sturdy bone, best of feet, good bend of stifle with good width in thigh. Well let down hocks, moved with drive, keeping a firm top line. Shown in top condition.

2<sup>nd</sup> Stacks Izznberr Chip off T' old Block. Gold of overall quality and type, eye-catching outline, slightly longer than class winner, sound in movement and show in fine order.

Class 21 – Open (Ent 5, abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Hackett's SH CH Lindridge Diamond Geeza. Eye-catching blue that has quality and type in a package that is unmistakably cockery. Well made throughout with balance and substance. Masculine head, superb front assembly with gentle flow of neck into super lay of shoulders and return of upper arm. Good depth and width to fore-chest, standing of strong bone. Lovely well-padded feet, standing four-square from all angles. Big in rib and short coupled, strong in rear quarters with good width of thigh keeping a firm top-line while moving and in the stand. Trimmed to advantage, enhancing his qualities. Moved soundly. DCC.

Was thrilled to see him awarded BIS by decision of the referee.

2<sup>nd</sup> Pearce Gudger's SH CH Cachel Prince Charming of Pearkeni JW. Quality orange roan who possess many qualities and has much to be admired. Masculine head with kind eye and expression, super flow of neck line, solid in construction making a pleasing outline. Although not the substance of the winner, a lovely example of the breed. Balanced in front and rear angulations, moved with drive and purpose with a happy cocker attitude. Shown in fine order and coat in full bloom.

3<sup>rd</sup> Cox's SH CH Gardenstone Pale Rider to Suvern JW.
