BITCHES

Thanks to the Officers and Committee and my efficient stewards for an enjoyable day. A very interesting entry to judge with some hotly contested classes and some exciting youngsters coming through which bodes well for the future. On the minus side, it was disappointing to see quite a few bitches in soft condition & lacking in muscle tone which did nothing for their movement. I also found presentation quite mixed with quite a few untidy coats and some bitches carrying far too much feathering which hid their outline – sometimes less is more.

SPECIAL RED/GOLDEN/LIVER/LIVER & TAN 2(1) **PUPPY**

- 1 Young's Canyon Classical Music, very balanced pup, good straight legs and neat feet, compact body, good rear angulation, sound and happy on the move
- 2 Warrington's Zakova Sunshine, another promising pup, good neck & shoulders, excellent bone, good ribs, merry mover, head just needs to develop a little more

GRADUATE 2(1)

- 1 Wyeth's Fendrove Dizzy Blonde, well-made girl, attractive head, plenty of substance, neat, well-padded feet, good neck & shoulders, strong quarters, moved out soundly and with enthusiasm, well presented
- 2 Grist's Kasordon Wildfire, pretty girl, compact well-ribbed body, very happy on the move if a little erratic, not quite the substance or head of 1

OPEN 2(1)

- 1 Marris-Bray's Helenwood Gift Wrapped, appealed for her honest, Cockery type, pleasing head, compact body, good ribs, happy and sound on the move
- 2 Share-Jones' Sharemead Golden Locks, pretty head, good neck and shoulders, strong bone, short big ribbed body, just not as positive on the move as 1

BLACK/BLACK & TAN 3(1) **PUPPY**

- 1 Robertson's Kastrian Illustration, lovely headed puppy, sweet expression, good bone, neat feet, good neck & shoulders, compact in body, immaculate presentation, moved out happily, just needs to strengthen a little in hind movement, liked her v much.
- 2 Kerry's Claramand In Disguise at Corbeara, different type to 1, appealing head, good bone and substance, compact body, merry mover, preferred the neck and shoulders of 1
- 3 Fairbrother's Lilyvale Started With A Kiss

GRADUATE 4

- 1 Kew's Withiflor Wheels On Fire at Wyllyview, loved the balance and type of this B/T girl, pretty head with such a sweet expression, good straight front, neat feet, compact big ribbed body, firm topline, well presented, merry mover
- 2 Hillary's Edasiy Dream Maker, well-made girl, plenty of substance all through, strong well-muscled quarters, moved well, not quite the topline of 1
- 3 Warren's Shadowside Yes Miss

OPEN 3

- 1 Robinson & Price's Sh Ch Molkara Anastasia with Jozelah JW, this girl appealed for her Cockery type, good neck and shoulders, good front and neat feet, short well-ribbed body, excels on the move, so sound and merry, well presented
- 2 Pilkington's Molkara Vuvuzela ShCM, lots to like about this girl, good bone and substance, big ribs, strong well-muscled quarters, positive mover
- 3 Davies' Canigou Abba Nice Day at Annaside

- 2 Bavin's Rojoys Chase The Dream, dark b/r girl of honest, unexaggerated type, attractive head, good shoulders & upper arm angulation, plenty of substance but still feminine, firm topline, moved positively & soundly, well presented, BMPB
- 3 Fairbairn & Madigan's Misperros Silver Lining at Carmelfair

- 1 Walker's Brackenjack Whoopsy Daisy, quality b/r, honest, unexaggerated type, everything just fits together well, appealing head and expression, well-boned legs and neat feet, sturdy, compact body with big ribs, well-angulated quarters, moved out well with style and purpose, well presented, CC & RBIS
- 2 Collier's Gardenstone Glamour Girl at Pepperbox, pretty headed b/r, good bone and substance, well-made all through but just not as compact as 1, sound and happy on the move
- 3 Potter's Poshtails Sweet Temptation

- 1 Kew's Manchela Startime at Wyllyview JW, dark b/r, honest well-balanced type, good bone and substance, well-made all through, good ribs, moved happily but a little erratically behind, well presented

- 2 Pearce's Miska Kay Sera Sera ShCM, good headed blk girl, plenty of substance, well-constructed all through, good presentation, moved out well but not quite the reach of 1

- 1 Moutrey's Sunzo Sonatina, well-made blk with appealing head and expression, good neck & shoulders, plenty of substance but still feminine, in good hard condition, no flabby muscles here, moved positively, immaculate presentation
- 2 Corcoran's Troverothway Just So, smaller type but attractive B/T with strong bone and big ribs, good front and neat feet, short sturdy body, very merry mover, just preferred the shoulder angulation of 1
